**Sub: Recruitment norms /Advertisement for Engaging Teachers on Contract Basis, in AECS-Manuguru, HWPM Colony, Aswapuram, Bhadradri Kothagudem, Telangana for the Academic year 2026-27**

It is proposed to conduct a Skill test and Practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching class) for engaging teachers on contract basis against the leave/regular vacancies that may arise during the Academic Year 2026-27. The details of post, pay, eligibility criterion and minimum and maximum age limits are given below.

**I. Educational and other qualification for the Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT) Post**

1. Three years Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with at least 50%marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms) in the respective subject(s) / combination of respective subjects.(Refer Table-1)

OR

Four years integrated degree course - B.A.Ed. or B.Sc.Ed. from Regional College of Education of NCERT/ from any National Council for Teacher Education recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms)in the respective subject(s)combination of respective subjects.

1	TGT (English)	English as an elective/major subject in graduation in all the three years.
2	TGT(Social Science)	Graduation with any two of the following elective/major subjects in all the three years: History, Geography, Economics and Political Science of which One must be either History or Geography.
3	TGT (Hindi/Sanskrit)	Hindi or Sanskrit as an elective/major subject in Graduation for all the three years. OR Post Graduation in Hindi/Sanskrit with minimum 50% marks may be considered for graduate candidates (BA-Humanities) with no requisite subject in graduation and no required percentage in graduation provided they have studied Hindi mandatorily in Class-X, XII and B.Ed(Teaching Subject as Hindi) and have qualified CTET (Paper-II)
4	TGT (Mathematics/Physics)	Mathematics & Physics as subjects in all the three years of graduation.

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5	TGT (Chemistry/Biology)	Chemistry and any one of Botany or Zoology as subject in all the three years of graduation.
6	TGT (Computer Science)	B.Sc (Computer Science/B.Sc (IT)/BCA or Equivalent from a recognized University with at least 50 % marks in aggregate by which Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with a method of conversion of corresponding University's/Institution's norms OR B.E. or B.Tech. (Computer Science/IT/Computer Engineering) from a recognized University or equivalent Degree with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which/Degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms) OR "A" Level from "DOEACC", Ministry of information and Communication Technology with at least 50% marks in aggregate by which degree is awarded by the University or equivalent CGPA (obtained by conversion to percentage in accordance with the method of conversion of corresponding University's/institution's norms) and passed graduation in any subject from a recognized University. B.Ed Degree with at least 50% marks from NCTE recognized institution/University.
7	TGT(Special Educator)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Three years Bachelor's Degree in any subject. and B.Ed. (Special Education). OR</li> <li>• Candidates passing in graduation may be considered provided they fulfill other mandatory norms. Ed in any subject other than special education and Post Graduate Professional Diploma(Approved by the Rehabilitation Council of India) in Special Education.</li> </ul> <p>The candidate must be registered with the Rehabilitation Council of India.</p>

1. B.Ed. or equivalent degree from any recognized University /Institute.
2. Qualified in Paper-II of Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET) conducted by the CBSE in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
3. Proficiency in teaching in English medium (except for TGT(Hindi/Sanskrit)

**Note: Candidates without B.Ed. and CTET can also apply if they have secured 60% and above marks (for Science Subjects) and 55% and above marks (for Humanities Subjects) in the Graduation level.**

**Note: Graduates can also apply for the post of PRTs, if the Candidates with +2 with D.Ed are not available.**

**III. Candidates without teaching qualification (B.Ed.,D.El.Ed,B.EL.Ed,CTET) can also apply and will be empanelled separately on selection.**

**IV. Mode of Selection:**

1. **Skill Test & Demo Teaching Class :** Every Candidate must come with prior preparation of one topic of subject as per his/her choice according to the level of post applied for. One topic will be given on the spot for DEMO Teaching for which the candidate will be asked to pick one topic out of the basket of topics. If a candidate is not comfortable with the topic picked by him /her , one more chance to pick another sealed envelope/paper will be given. The number of chances for picking the topic shall be 02 (maximum). Duration of Skill Test & DEMO Teaching Class :20 Minutes( 10 Minutes+10Minutes) ; 10 Minutes topic chosen by self and 10 minutes for the topic provided by the school on the day of skill test.
2. Fifteen minutes time will be given to the candidates for preparation for topic allotted on the spot for SKILL TEST & DEMO Teaching. The candidate may use appropriate Teaching Aids during Skill Test and DEMO Teaching.

3. (a) A skill test and Practical classroom observation (or a Demo Teaching Class) will be conducted and the selected candidates will be empanelled and recruited in the order of merit.  
(b) Performance of the candidates will be assessed based on presentation by the candidates on two topics, one chosen by self and other provided by the school followed by personnel interaction on the subject
4. **3 Panels will be prepared:**
  - a. Panel -I – Candidates with all the requisite qualifications for TGTs, PRTs and Balvatika teachers separately
  - b. Panel -II–Candidates without CTET score for TGTs and PRTs separately
  - c. Panel-III–Candidates without teaching qualification for TGTs, PRTs and Balavatika teachers separately
5. The panels mentioned above will be operated in sequential order viz. in the order of their merit.
6. The panel is valid for one year–1<sup>st</sup> April 2026 to 31<sup>st</sup> March 2027
7. If the performance of the Contract teacher, anytime during the period of contract, is not found as per the required standards, the contract can be terminated (regular class room teaching will be observed by the school authorities).
8. Contract teachers have to follow Conduct Rules prescribed by AEES during the service. Violation of Conduct of Rules can lead to termination of contract.

3. Candidates must submit separate applications for each post, if applying for more than one post.
4. No TA/DA is admissible for attending Skill test
5. If no candidate is empanelled for Balavatika teacher, PRT short listed candidate will be given offer for Balavatika Teacher and should be willing to teach Balavatika Classes.
6. Retired teachers from AEES/KVS/NVS, Who are below the age of 65 years are also eligible to apply. They have to appear for skill test & Demo class.
7. If appointed on contract basis candidate should be ready to teach online, if required.
8. No correspondence will be entertained in any matter related to this advertisement, Canvassing in any form will lead to disqualification.
